Bridge:

if you are ignored and disparaged, if you are disappointed and hurt,
a C G 2F F C2 C F G C
did you lose confidence and courage and you miss encouraging words,
a G F G4 G a D G4 G
when you see all your efforts will fail and all your endeavors are in vain,
C F C F C G A4 A
when your mental state is anything but hale, and when all problems cause confusion and pain,
d G C4 C
and when all problems cause confusion and pain.
